# DO store your wedding dress in a cool, dry place:

Keep your gown somewhere consistently cool and dry, away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.





### DON'T store your dress in basements or lofts:

Areas with fluctuating temperatures and humidity can damage the fabric and cause mould growth.



### DO use a breathable garment bag:

Opt for a breathable fabric garment bag to prevent moisture build-up and allow air circulation, avoiding mould and mildew.



#### DON'T use plastic garment bags:

Plastic can trap moisture, leading to mould and mildew, and may release harmful chemicals over time.



# DO have the dress professionally cleaned after the wedding:

Professional cleaning removes stains and oils that could cause damage over time, ensuring the dress remains pristine.



# DON'T delay cleaning the dress after the wedding:

Prompt cleaning prevents stains from setting and becoming trickier to remove.



# DO use acid-free materials for long-term storage:

Acid-free tissue paper and boxes prevent yellowing, fabric damage, and creases from becoming permanent, protecting delicate embellishments.



### DON'T hang the dress for long-term storage:

Hanging for extended periods can cause the fabric to stretch and distort, especially for heavier gowns.



### DO lay the dress flat if possible:

If space allows, laying the dress flat reduces stress on seams and fabric.



# DON'T expose your dress to light and moisture:

Storing your gown in places with direct sunlight or high humidity can cause discolouration and fabric deterioration.
