How would you describe the service you provide?

What can we and can we not do on the day?

What ceremony area options are available for all-weather conditions?

Are you able to cater for our dietary requirements?

Do you have a wet weather plan?

How long can we hold a date for?

What are they payment terms?

What is included as complimentary?

Are there any hidden extras?

Who will be my contact throughout the planning stages and will it be the same person on the day?

How many bedrooms do you have on-site?

Ask about ceremony options - just because they have a wedding license, doesn't mean you have to do the legal part there. You can book a celebrant, too.
